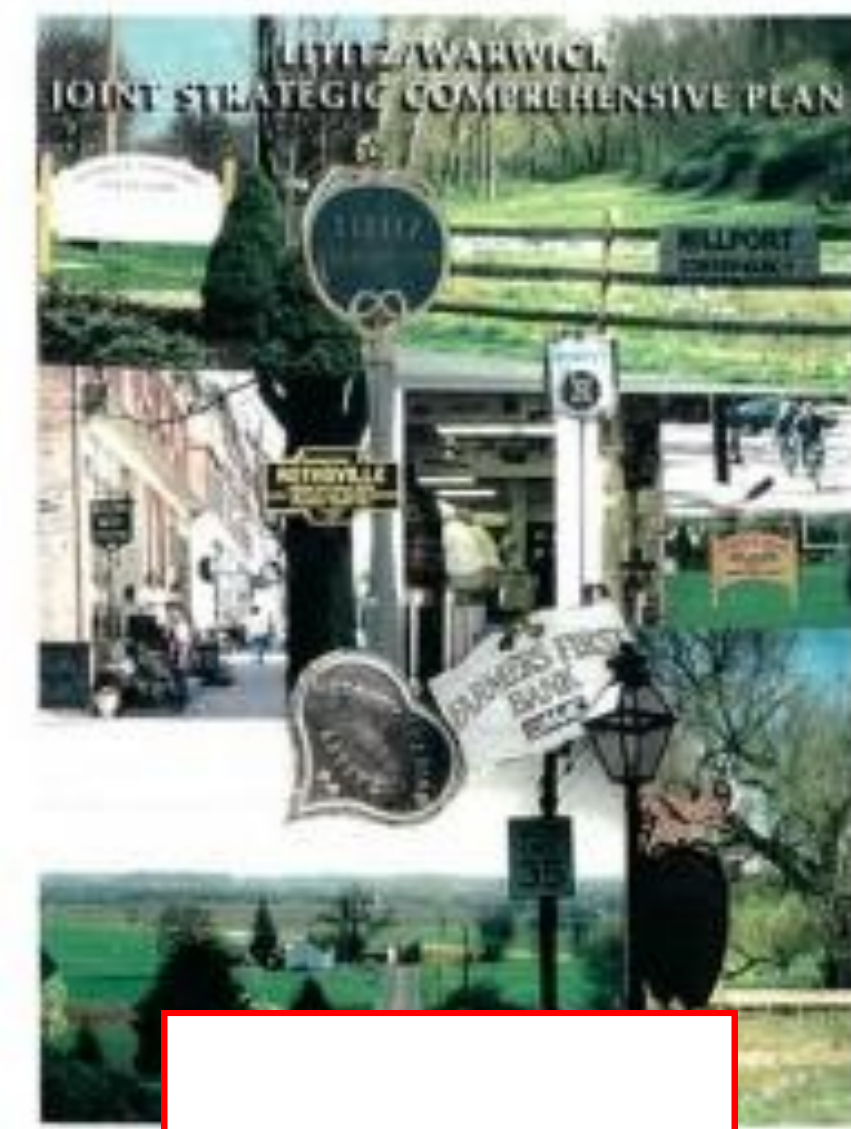
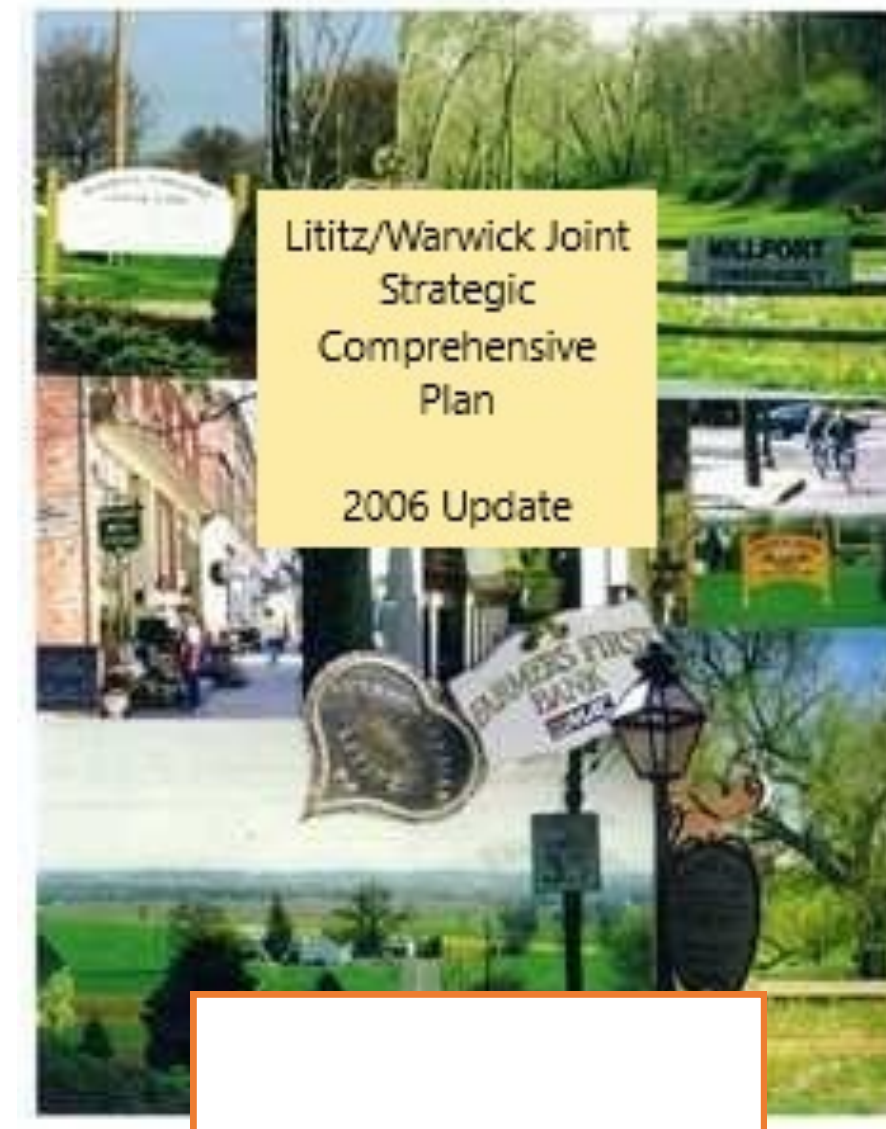

- Pedestrian crosswalk improvements are made along Broad and Main Streets**
- Over 5,000 5th grade students have participated in the LRWA Warwick Watershed Day**
- Lititz Borough implements a rental inspection program**
- Development of the Rock Lititz Campus begins**
- Construction begins on the 6th Street extension from West Orange St. to SR 772**
- Farmland preservation reaches 3,000 acres**

An update to the Plan was written in 2006, and then in 2017 Elizabeth Township joined the strategic comprehensive planning process and Impact 2017 was written. With all the municipalities in the Warwick School District and the school district itself participating, Forge the Future 2022 was adopted in 2018.
